The Guadalupe Harber Scholarship: *Guadalupe Harber was an undergraduate student in the Division of Bicultural-Bilingual Studies studying to become a bilingual teacher who served as president of BESO. This scholarship was established in 1984 by BESO and the BBL faculty to honor her memory.*

The Rodolfo Jacobson Scholarship: *Dr. Rodolfo Jacobson is a former director and faculty member of the Division of Bicultural-Bilingual Studies, and the first Title VII Director of BBL. This scholarship was established by BESO and the BBL faculty in honor of Dr. Jacobson's contributions to bilingual education.*

To be eligible for these scholarships you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be enrolled at The University of Texas at San Antonio as an **undergraduate student**.
- Must be actively pursuing teacher certification in **Bilingual Education**.
- Must be an **active member** of the Bilingual Education Student Organization (BESO) as defined by the organization's constitution.
- At the time of application, must have *either* a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least **2.5** on a 4.0 scale **<OR>** a minimum UTSA GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
