

The Baptist Health Foundation Scholarship in Nutrition and Dietetics *

This scholarship is open only to students in the Coordinated Dietetics Program for a B.S. and M.S. in Nutrition and Dietetics.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: October 31, 2017

The Nutrition and Dietetics Scholarship was established in 2016 with funds from the Baptist Health Foundation of San Antonio Scholarship Program. This scholarship is not renewable; however, if additional funds become available, recipients are encouraged to re-apply.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must meet ALL of the following requirements at time of application and award receipt:

- Must be a **permanent resident in one of the Foundation's eight county service area (Bexar and contiguous)** and whose intent, following graduation, **is to remain and seek employment in said area.**
- Must be a **current UTSA undergraduate senior, post-bac or graduate student,**
- Must be **admitted to the Coordinated Program in Dietetics and enrolled in at least 10 semester hours** in CPD coursework.
- Must have at least 90 credit hours of which 22 hours must be Nutrition and Dietetics coursework completed by the semester the award is disbursed, i.e., by the start of the Spring semester.
- Must have an overall cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by UTSA's Financial Aid Office**
- Must submit a completed application and required essay as outlined below, by the application deadline indicated above.

****The UTSA Financial Aid Office will determine your financial need for this scholarship based on a completed FAFSA. FAFSA applications for the current academic year can be submitted starting October 1. If you have not submitted a FAFSA yet, please do so as early as possible.**
