

THE HAROLD T. AND H. JOYCE COOK SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 30, 2018

This scholarship is **renewable** on an annual basis for a maximum of three years as long as funds remain available and required criteria are met. **Among equally qualified applicants, those seeking certification in 4-8th grades will be given priority.**

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be enrolled at The University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) as an undergraduate student for at least six credit hours. (Post baccalaureate students seeking certification are not eligible.)
- Must be actively pursuing an Interdisciplinary Studies Degree (IDS) with certification at the **EC-4/EC-6 or 4-8 level**.
- Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must have *applied for or been accepted* into the COEHD Teacher certification program *by the semester the scholarship funds are to be awarded*.
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by UTSA's Financial Aid office.**

****The UTSA Financial Aid Office will determine your financial need for this scholarship based on a completed FAFSA. FAFSA applications for the current academic year can be submitted starting January 1. If you have not submitted a FAFSA yet, please do so as early as possible.**
