The Onderdonk Family Memorial Scholarship was established in 1989 by former UTSA faculty member, Dr. Martha S. Jones, in honor of the maternal side of her family, many of whom were educators. Dr. Jones established the scholarship to assist students during the student teaching semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be enrolled at The University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA), part-time or full-time, for at least two semesters prior to the Clinical teaching semester.
- Must do **Clinical teaching** in the semester for which the award will be given.
- Must be a **US citizen or permanent resident**.
- **Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.**
- Must submit a completed application form along with the documents requested below by the application deadline.
