

# The Katie N. Reed Endowed Scholarship

APPLICATION DEADLINE: **March 30, 2018**

**To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:**

- Enrolled at UTSA as an **undergraduate, post-bac** student at the UG level or **entering freshmen** student seeking teacher certification at the undergraduate level.
- Must be a **first generation college student**. Neither of the student's parents attended a college or a university.
- Must be a COEHD major **<OR>** *if not a COEHD major*, must be admitted into the UTSA Teacher Certification Program.
- Must be enrolled in 12 credit hours, unless enrolled in Student Teaching semester.
- At the time of application, must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Entering freshmen must have a minimum SAT score of 1100 and/or a minimum ACT score of 24/26.
- Must demonstrate the need for financial assistance as determined by UTSA's Office of Student Financial Aid. \*\*
- Preference will be given to the following groups: **middle school and high school level certifications**; graduates from any **Northside ISD high schools in San Antonio, TX** and who have demonstrated participation/leadership in community volunteering and/or extracurricular activities.

**\*\*The UTSA Financial Aid Office will determine your financial need for this scholarship based on a completed FAFSA. FAFSA applications for the current academic year can be submitted starting October 1. If you have not submitted your FAFSA yet, please do so as early as possible.**
