PARTNERSHIP UPDATES

TWAIN DUAL LANGUAGE ACADEMY:

Southwest ISD district leaders will tour Twain on March 23rd. Twain is known for their ability to design their own in-house professional development sessions by leveraging their teachers' instructional strengths in the classroom. Teacher collaborative planning and data analysis protocols are key elements in Twain's success.

IRVING DUAL LANGUAGE ACADEMY:

Every grade level K-5th teacher at Irving effectively implements the following strategies: Lotta Lara, The Dictado, Diario Duo and Literacy-based ELD at 100%. Irving is known for their focus on cultural competence as another core component of their program which ensures high cross-cultural competencies necessary for success in a diverse global society.

BONHAM ACADEMY:

Bonham offers two intercultural offerings. At the elementary level, Bonham offers a weekly Zoom Spanish club led by Sara Quezada. In the middle school, they offer a Mexican American Studies (MAS) elective led by Ms. Manriquez.

TEXAS COVID LEARNING ACCELERATED SUPPORTS (TCLAS)

The Texas COVID Learning Acceleration Supports (TCLAS) is a set of funding and targeted supports available to Local Education Agencies (LEAs) to accelerate student learning in the wake of COVID-19. Through this funding, UTSA will now offer The Signature Teacher Residency program to provide direct customized support to partner districts and participating mentor teachers.

Dr. Belinda Flores, the Associate Dean of Professional Preparation & Partnerships and Principal Investigator & Founder of the Academy for Teacher Excellence Research Center at the University of Texas at San Antonio's College of Education and Human Development (UTSA COEHD), conveyed the positive impact the teacher paid residencies in the current climate, as the COVID health pandemic presented new needs for LEAs and exacerbated existing challenge areas such as staffing shortages, teacher retention, the student digital divide, and mental wellness needs.




