M.S. Clinical Mental Health Counseling

During the 2024 – 2025 academic year, 102 students successfully graduated from the Clinical Mental Health Counseling program (CMHC). To the best of our knowledge, the pass rate for the National Counselor Examination ranged between 71% and 80%. Based on available data, approximately 88% of graduates seeking employment secured counseling-related positions or were admitted into doctoral programs within 180 days of graduation. Additionally, for the CMHC program, 100% of our students completed their program within 6 years.

M.Ed. School Counseling

During the 2024 – 2025 academic year, 11 students graduated from the School Counseling (SCOU) program. Of these students, 70 - 80% of graduates seeking jobs were able to secure employment in a counseling-related position within 180 days of graduation. To the best of our knowledge, the pass rate for the National Counselor Examination ranged between 91% and 100%. For the SCOU program, 100% of our students completed their program within 5 years.

Ph.D. Counselor Education and Supervision

During the 2024 - 2025 academic year, six students earned their doctorates in Counselor Education and Supervision. All graduates (100%) secured employment in a related field within 180 days of program completion. Additionally, the Ph.D. program achieved a 67% completion rate within the projected three-year timeframe, with two graduates completing the program beyond this period due to enrollment in earlier program structures or extended timelines. No additional certification or licensure exams are required for doctoral students beyond the entry-level requirements.
