Our client populations include a variety of demographics but are generally not those experiencing serious mental health conditions (or if they are, their symptoms are managed). We do not have regularly scheduled groups, therefore an opportunity to provide group counseling may not be available to students. The number of clients assigned to a student counselor will be based on the number of hours required by the practicum program, client needs, and the student's availability. Students with open availability are preferred over students with very limited availability due to our having a wide variety of clinicians schedules and meeting the needs of clients. Current internship students are seeing about 10 clients a week on their own and co-counseling for additional hours with supervisors or mentors. No specific training is required for the student prior to being accepted for an internship here, but they will have access to the therapist monthly lunch 'n learn meetings. The ideal student counselor for our location is one who is ready to learn, willing to accept clients from all walks of life, and would like to experience how a health-insurance based practice runs. A student who wants to specialize with a very narrow client population might struggle to create a full caseload here, however.
