Courses submitted for consideration for transfer of credits must be equivalent and/or closely related to courses in the PhD in School Psychology program. For transfer of credits requests, students must complete the 'Transfer of Graduate Credit (Doctoral)' form (https://education.utsa.edu/student/resources/).

As indicated in the UTSA Graduate Catalog (https://catalog.utsa.edu/graduate/doctoraldegreeregulations/transferofcredit/), applicants with a master's degree in the field of the doctoral program of interest or related field may apply a maximum of 30 semester credit hours of previously earned graduate credit toward a post-baccalaureate doctoral degree program, pending approval from the Graduate Program Committee, academic College, and Dean of the Graduate School; provided the credit has not been used toward another doctoral degree. Students that are granted the maximum 30 semester credits hours via a transfer of credits may graduate the program in as few as 4 years instead of the typical 5 years.
