# **UEI Project Updates**

#### PROJECTS:

We are continuing our partnership with the City of San Antonio to evaluate its ambitious **Ready to Work** program. This program provides comprehensive job training, including case management and employer engagement, to help San Antonio citizens climb the economic ladder. We are continuing our partnership with **Celebrate Dyslexia** to investigate the educational and workforce outcomes of students with dyslexia, informing that early screening and appropriate intervention are critical to enhancing individual achievement, career success, and broader social benefits. Additionally, we have partnered with **UP Partnership** to enhance the quality and scope of counseling services for students in San Antonio, promoting foundational knowledge, ambition, and pathways to success in both secondary and postsecondary education.

UEI has collaborated with faculty and researchers from three institutions—the University of Texas at El Paso, Texas Tech University, and E3 Alliance—to study access, equity, and the impact of Texas's **dual credit** program. As a steering committee member of LonestaRP3 — a network of policymakers, researchers, and practitioners across the state — we have been collaborating closely with constituents across Texas to identify pressing educational policy issues and topics. Our recent Dual Credit project is the latest manifestation of that collaboration.

We are grateful for the generous funding from our supporters, including the City of San Antonio, Celebrate Dyslexia, UP Partnership, the University of Texas at Austin, and the Gates Foundation, which enables these research opportunities.

We're excited to introduce UEI's newest researcher, **Dr. Elisa Serrano**. Dr. Serrano is a postdoctoral research fellow at the Urban Education Institute. She earned her Ph.D. in Curriculum and Instruction with an emphasis in Language, Culture, and Society from Pennsylvania State University. Her research and teaching focus on multilingual learners, educational equity, and identity in schooling.
